

ST adds 60 CNG Buses in its fleet

The MSRTC (Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation) have added 60 eco-friendly CNG buses to its fleet. These buses have been fabricated at MSRTC's Central Workshops located at Pune & Aurangabad. All these vehicles are plying in and around Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and Panvel areas.

After initial tests, the R & D wing of MSRTC have incorporated a few changes to the interior design of the buses. Hence now, the seats are arranged in 2x2 instead of the earlier 2x3 formation making seating more comfortable and also gives more space for passengers standing. Two openings instead of one makes passengers' entry & exit much faster and with less confusion. The buses painted 'Tomato Red' provides for attractive exterior appeal and the interiors too have a pleasant feel.

These eco-friendly buses will go a long way in helping curbing pollution levels in the surroundings and also prove cost effective on diesel consumption.
